

Anti-bullying Survey November 2017

A summary of the pupils' feedback

Approximately sixty children from Year 3 – 6 were asked to share their thoughts about bullying. Below is a summary of some of their thoughts/ideas.

What does the word 'bullying' mean to you?

"When someone is constantly being rude to you and they do not want you around."

"Bullying hurts people's feelings."

"Bullying means hurting someone's feelings, calling people names and making them feel left out."

"Being bullied...it is a sad feeling."

"Being selfish and hurting other people's feelings."

"Bullying means hurting people's feelings and doing physical violence to other children."

How successful is the school at dealing with bullying?

What is going well?

"We sort out bullying with our friends and an adult."

"The teachers help us to sort our bullying. . .we have to talk."

"The play leaders discuss the bullying with the children."

"The school deals with bullying quickly."

"The children know that we need show respect to each other."

"The school is good at solving problems."

"The playground teacher stays in a certain area. . .this helps."

"They investigate. . .the school gets to the bottom of what happened."

"The teaching assistants put the children on green, yellow or red."

Even better if. . .

"If there was no more bullying."

"It would be better if teachers always noticed when it was happening."

"There could be Year 6 'Bully Helpers' to help stop bullying."

"Everyone was always kind to each other."

"If there was more staff outside at playtime and lunchtime."

"If teachers could always deal with the bully...put them up a colour."

"To have Year 6 'Bullying Monitors' to help the children if they didn't want to tell an adult".

"We could stop all bullying...maybe ask children to politely play with each other."
