Our Value for this March is **Interdependence** and **Democracy**. These pupils modelled the value this week:





It was a great day for lots of reading for pleasure and reading with children in different classes.







Table tennis World Cup at the Copper box

"On Friday 23rd February, Year 5 went on a trip to the International Table Tennis Federation World Cup at the Copper box Arena in the Olympic Park, East London. The event was a highlight of the sport's calendar and particularly special for the children to see as it was the first major international Table Tennis tournament to be hosted by London in over 60 years. In preparation for their visit, the children were taught the rules of the game and were given the opportunity to practice new skills with the schools' new Table Tennis facilities.

The children were able to play some short games before the tournament started and even played against a machine, which was very tricky! England were in action throughout the day and faired well, finishing second in their group, with strong home support provided by POW and other London schools."
