

Autumn Term: During the autumn term Father Stephen from our local church St Peter and Paul joined our Harvest Festival assembly. Towards Christmas Year 1 visited St Peter and Paul Church and Father Stephen told the nativity story which the children acted out.



Year 2 choir with Miss Toye and Mrs Redmore went along to St Peter and Paul Church on a Saturday afternoon to sing carols at the church's Christmas Fair. Father Stephen also joined Prince of Wales for our Carols around the Tree assembly.



Spring Term: During the first half of the spring term Year 1 were learning about Islam and visited the Ponders End Islamic Centre (Enfield Mosque). Three different areas of the Mosque were viewed where different guides shared different aspects of the Muslim faith. One guide showed the Qur'an, another guide demonstrated the 'call to prayer' and the third showed praying areas. The children had opportunities to look closely at different aspects of the Mosque and to ask/answer questions.





During Religious Education lessons Year 5 explored 'Christian values in the world today' and visitors from Christian Aid came into class to share their work. The teddy bear in the photo is now the Christian Aid Mascot who travels around

the world. There were discussions about the fairness/unfairness in the world and pupils acted the story of the Good Samaritan in a modern football scenario - moral of the parable being 'love your neighbour as yourself'.

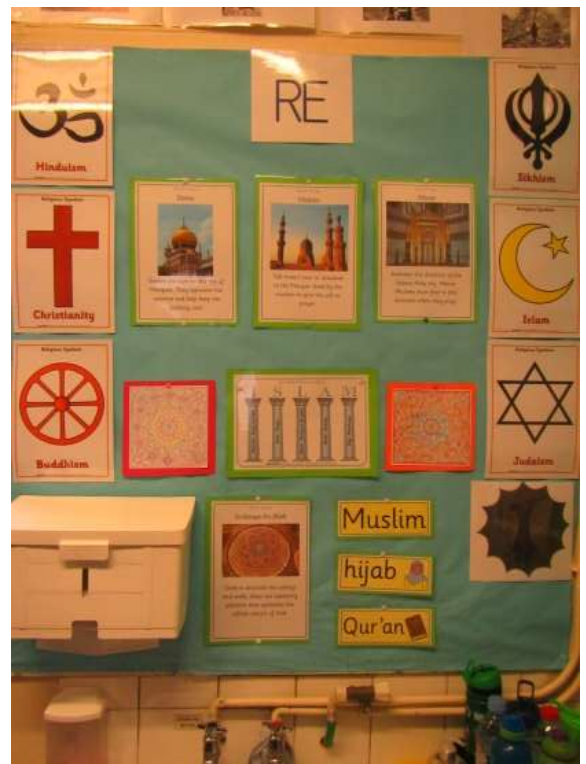
