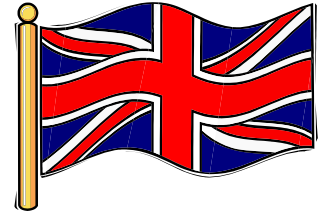

Diamond Jubilee

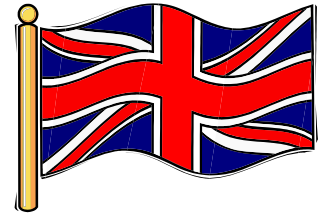
