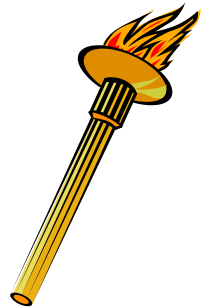
Year 5 visit to the CLC
