Values-based Education at Prince of Wales

The philosopher Montessori (1870 – 1952) developed the idea that a school should be based on a model of the 'ideal family' e.g. a safe, calm, secure and loving environment. She wanted schools to be linked to families and their local community. These ideas form the foundation of Values-based education. We now have 'families' in KS1 and KS2. Our intention was to create a sense of community within the school. Children develop a healthy sense of self when they experience belonging.
