Are you entitled to claim for Free School Meals? In order to be eligible the parent/carer should be in receipt of one of the following:

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- **Employment and Support Allowance (IR)**
- Assisted as an Asylum Seeker under part VI of the Immigration Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit only, and have an annual income of less
 - £16,190 (this figure is updated each year from 6th April)
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit.
