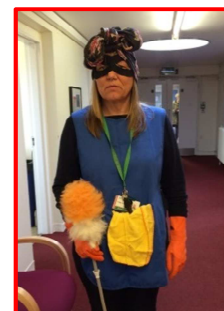

"I liked the snake and the car games. Also it makes me better at Maths." Darrell

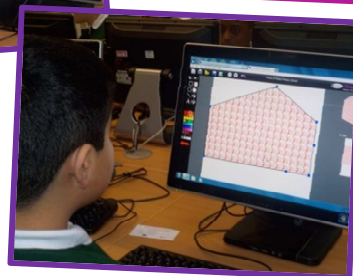
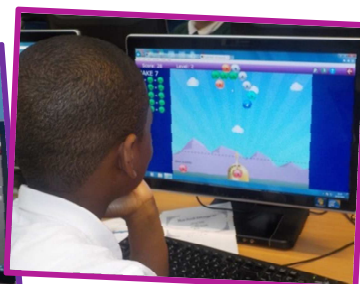
"Purple Mash helps with English and Maths skills. You can learn from it." Elijah
