It was investigated immediately and we informed both the police and Enfield council by 9.15am. Our children were upset to read the messages as they understood they were wrong. Despite the implications in the local and national press we pride ourselves on being a culturally diverse and inclusive school. It was clear that multiple messages were written along a quarter of a mile of pavement with our school happening to be along this route. It was a pity that some reported comments appeared to sensationalise this event. We are grateful to the many parents who have responded in a pragmatic and supportive way, understanding that this was *not* a reflection of our school.

Next week will be another first for our school when Cirque Normandie sets up their tent on our school field. On Thursday and Friday children from the Children's Centre and school will have the opportunity to practice circus skills.
