### Late collections and the procedure for un-collected children

Children feel anxious when not collected at the correct time. We wish to minimise this by ensuring that all children are collected at the appropriate time.

Parents who persistently collect their children late from school will now receive a letter explaining the impact this has on children and the school. We follow the local authority policy that also states that we will contact Children's Social Services and Safer Schools Police Officers, if children are persistently collected late.

After this notice a charge will apply for each child at the cost of £5 for every five minutes late to be paid via Parent Pay within 7 days of the date of the letter.

Make sure you know what time your child finishes at the end of the day as this varies between key stages.





# Value for February: Kindness

In this week's assembly, the children heard the story 'Have you filled a bucket today?' by Carol McCloud. The story encourages positive behaviour by using the concept of an invisible bucket. The children were shown how easy it is to spread kindness by 'filling buckets' with kind deeds. However, any negative behaviour is called 'bucket dipping' and takes away other people's happiness. We can fill or dip into our own buckets too... Some of the pupils in 4F shared their thoughts about 'Kindness' and how to be a 'bucket filler'.

## Kindness by Kene (4F)

You can show kindness by being respectful. Also by being helpful, and making people feel welcome...and by having manners.

## Kindness by Chloe (4F)

Kindness means being nice to others not only your friends but enemies too.

Not only through your actions but your words. Three examples of kindness:

- I. If someone is hurt, ask what is wrong and take him or her to medical.
- 2. Play with others.
- 3. Talk to others.

## Kindness by Mei-Lien (4F)

Kindness means friendship. Helping others when in need. Showing respect to each other. Being nice to one another. Being the best you can be. It means listening to each other. It means being nice all the time and not just when you want something.

## Kindness by Remi (4F)

Kindness means helping others and caring. You can stand up for someone that is being bullied and play with that person that has no one to play with
