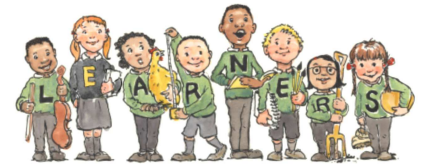

On Wednesday we remembered those who were and are affected by war, especially those who fought and lost their lives for our freedom.

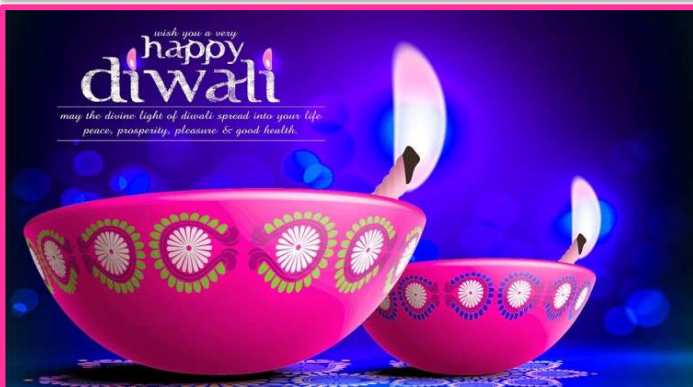
Year 6 – Romeo and Juliet – Thursday 5th November

Have a go at this puzzle at home. Feel free to come and tell us when you have found the answer or wait for the answer in next weeks newsletter.

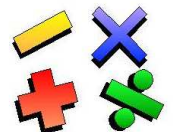
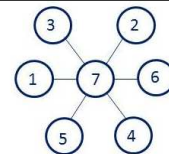
