Drop off and collection of children

Parents and carers, please take note of the following expectations:

KS1 An *adult* must take your child to school and wait in the playground until the children are collected by a member of staff. At the end of the day they must be collected by a responsible *adult*. The class teacher must have been notified in advance who the named adults are that can collect your child.

Years 3 and 4 Children must be dropped off and collected by a responsible person (ideally 18+) that is known to the teacher.


Years 5 and 6 Parents may give permission (form available at the office) for their child to come to and leave school on their own, unless the child's behaviour is a concern to the school (see behaviour policy). Children attending an after school club or returning from an educational visit after 4pm must be collected as well.
