Dear Parents, Carers, Governors and Friends,

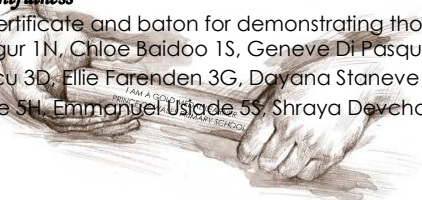

Punctuality

We are concerned that too many children arrive late at school in the morning. Late arrival impacts on essential learning such as our Daily Supported Reading Programme in Year 1 that starts at 9am every day. Already real progress can be seen by those children who come every day and on time.

Many children across KS1 and KS2 have pre-arranged 1:1 reading sessions with staff and late arrival means they may fail to benefit from this that week.

Likewise, children miss out on vital instructions they need later in the lesson.

Please remember you signed the Home-School agreement that clearly states that you will ensure that your child comes to school on time.
