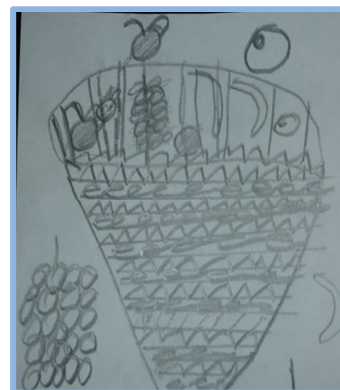

Values-based Education at Prince of Wales

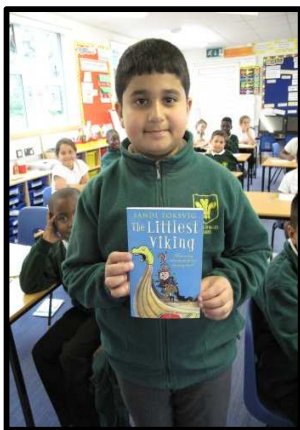
