Dear Parents/Carers/Parent Governors,

Let's Talk Education - an invitation to Enfield Parents/Carers and Parent Governors: Tuesday, 27 June 2017 at Bishop Stopford School

I am writing to invite you to a meeting with fellow parents/carers/parent governors and some of our headteachers to discuss the funding crisis that Enfield's schools are currently facing in the light of ongoing cuts.

I have real concerns that if no positive action is taken by the new Government to support our schools now as we face a severe funding shortage, we will have a situation where the achievements and outcomes for our children will be severely jeopardised.

In partnership with our schools, we are seeking to generate a local parents and community response to Government from Enfield to help highlight our concerns. I hope that if we can harness our collective voice we can urge Government to consider how best to sustainably fund schools and ensure a better funded education system for all our children.

The meeting will be held at: *Bishop Stopford School (Main Hall), Brick Lane, Enfield, EN1 3PU on Tuesday 27 June 2017 at 6pm.* The meeting will allow us to come together and discuss the issues facing our schools with a panel of local headteachers, who can help us understand the impact of changes to how schools are funded in the borough.
