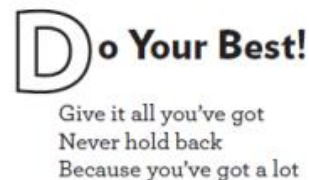
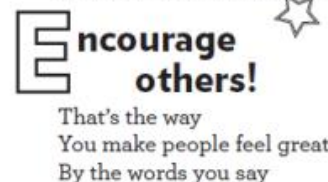
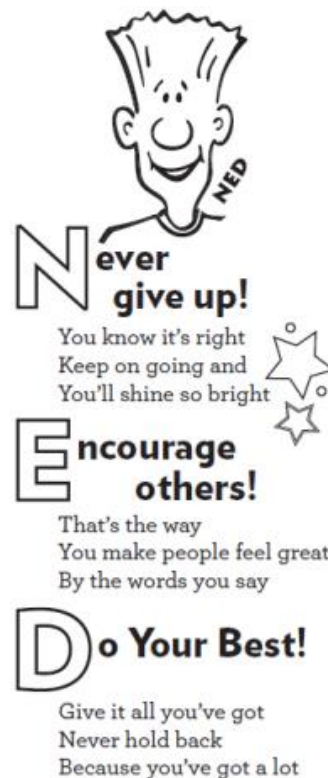
THE NED SHOW!
