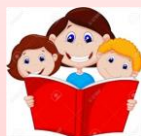

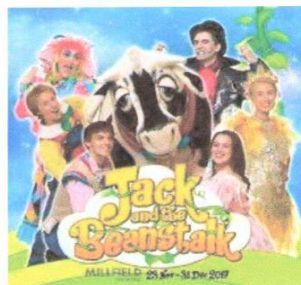
Christmas Pantomime outing for our members
