On Friday 9th we travelled to Washington DC the coach driver kindly made a detour via the white house so the team got to see the landmarks of Washington before heading to our hotel. We arrived, had some dinner and off we went again for training, an early night had by all that evening.

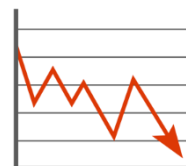
