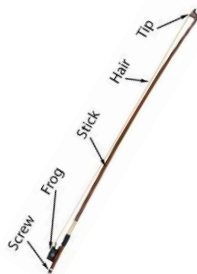

### School Meals Price increase

After much deliberation, from Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> April 2018 we will be increasing our school lunch price to **£2.50** per day - **£12.50** per week. Having subsidised school meals by significant amounts over the past years (about £60,000 per year), we are no longer able to do this as our school budget is under great pressure. The real cost to the school is currently £2.52 Savings will be used to support your children's learning. Thank you for your understanding.
