




Accelerated Reading Workshop

Reading for Pleasure


- Accelerated Reading is a program which records the books the children are choosing and reading
- After a Star test-4 times a year- it assesses the ZPD range so they are reading at the appropriate level
- It checks the child's understanding of the book
- It motivates the children to finish a book and take a quiz
- There are challenges in the classroom-100% club, Millionaires...
- The scores are recorded in the reading journals to inform parents

Diagnostic report-what do we do with the report?

- Encourage children to take quizzes within two days of reading the book
- Aim for over 85%
- Check book is appropriate-not too challenging so the child feels demotivated





Growth Reports

 Star assessments are taken 4 times a year, different for every child, and indicate progress and new ZPD range with corresponding reading age-this is just one indicator as to the child's progress in reading.

How can you help with AR?

- Discuss the book with the child-talk about what might happen, talk about their favourite character, imagine an alternative ending....
- Change the book if it is frustrating to read or they are clearly not interested in the story
- If they have enjoyed the book see if there are other books by the same author
- Ask them about how they performed on the quizzes
- · Speak to the classteacher if you have any concerns at all

Other ways you can help with reading for pleasure

- Read to your child
- See films/plays about books
- Go to the library and any book events
- Join in with the Reading Challenge
- Attend Reading Breakfasts
- Show the children that you enjoy reading
- Participate in the school Swap Shop
- Buy second hand books-Sainsburys, charity shops, Amazon for 1p
- Use audio books, kindle, books online....
