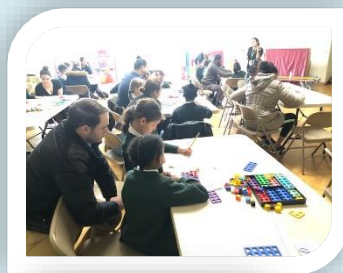
Year 2 Ocean Maths Café

Year 1 had their Ocean Maths Café this week where there was an opportunity for parents to come in and work with their child on a Number game. The focus of the Maths was addition and subtraction where we had to find missing numbers in number sentence and picture problems. We also investigated ways to find a given total using our 0-9 number cards. The café was a great opportunity to show our parents how we use songs as part of our learning in school and share links to songs to use at home. Everyone had lot of fun!



Year 5 – Transport for London

On Tuesday 19th March the Year 5 children enjoyed a one hour workshop delivered by Transport for London. The children learnt about the different ways to get around London and how there is a bigger push for people to take public transport to ease congestion and reduce the impact on the environment.

It was a hands on session with lots of activities to engage the children. These included building human bar charts, estimating peak times on the tubes, underground map reading and simulating different modes of transport around London. TfL shared some of the latest technology from Oyster cards to estimating pedestrian numbers. It was a fun and informative session that the children and staff all enjoyed.
