Ordnance Road: Road Closure

Dear Resident,

This letter is to inform you that Enfield Council will be putting in place a temporary road closure on Ordnance Road as part of the Cycle Enfield project.

From the 16th September 2019 until the end of November, Ordnance Road will be closed at the junction with Hertford Road

Access in and out of Ordnance Road will be via Mollison Avenue

Additional parking restrictions will apply
