PoW Remembers 11.11.2019

Our school marked its respect for Commonwealth soldiers and Allies past and present since WWI and all those affected by wars.

To commemorate **Remembrance Day** this year, a memorial was created by pupils, staff and visitors laying red, green or black painted stones in the shape of a large poppy on the school field. Miss Rowntree led the Remembrance Assembly, reminding our school community why it is so important to honour those that gave their lives for peace and freedom across the world. One child commented afterwards that he didn't realise that soldiers from the Caribbean also fought in the war.







Countries across the world remember in gratitude the Allied Soldiers – The Netherlands

The Netherlands was occupied during WWII and saw fierce fighting towards the end of the war, especially in the area bordering with Germany. The Dutch remember with gratitude the efforts of allied soldiers to liberate their country and every year remember the fallen. Mr Bless recently visited an area called Leudal that saw heavy fighting during and after Operation Marketgarden, where towns and villages were liberated from September to November 1944. This year being the 75th anniversary, the 700+ soldiers from 11 nationalities that died in that period are being commemorated through their personal stories. He recalled how a 1 year old toddler escaped bath time to crawl out of the house onto the street to join the cheering crowds as British Forces drove past. The infant in his 'birthday suit' was promptly 'adopted' by soldiers and placed on top of a tank. His anxious mother found him being paraded and accompanied by doodle bag players. That child grew up to become Mr Bless' father!

Demi in 5G showed her work about factors. For greater depth she was able to find out factors of 18 and 36. Children in assembly also knew how to find factors of numbers.



Steve McQueen Year 3 is a partnership between Tate, Artangel and A New Direction

Turner Prize-winning artist and Oscar-winning filmmaker Steve McQueen, together with Tate Britain, Artangel and A New Direction, unveil one of the most ambitious visual portraits of citizenship ever undertaken in one of the world's largest cities.

An epic portrait of the future of London - this vast new artwork captures thousands of local children, including **Prince of Wales'**, in a milestone year in their development. 76,146 Year 3 pupils from 1,504 London schools will be featuring in 3,128 class photographs in the Duveen Galleries at Tate Britain from 12 November 2019 - 03 May 2020.

Over the past week, you may have been aware of Year 3 class photographs popping up on over 600 billboards across London's 33 boroughs as part of an accompanying, city-wide outdoor exhibition organised by Artangel, which continues across London until 18 November 2019.


