Alternatively bring them along to Breakfast Club any morning from 7:30am – 8:30am

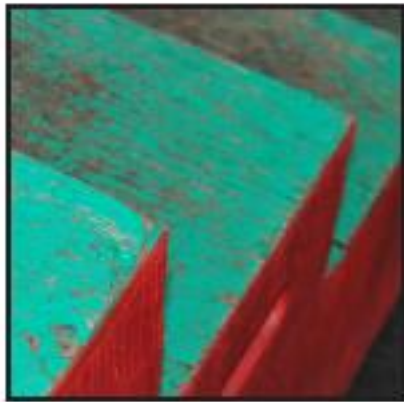

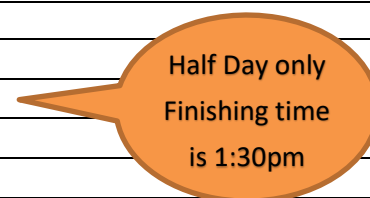
