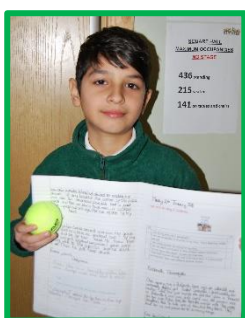
## Chinese New Year

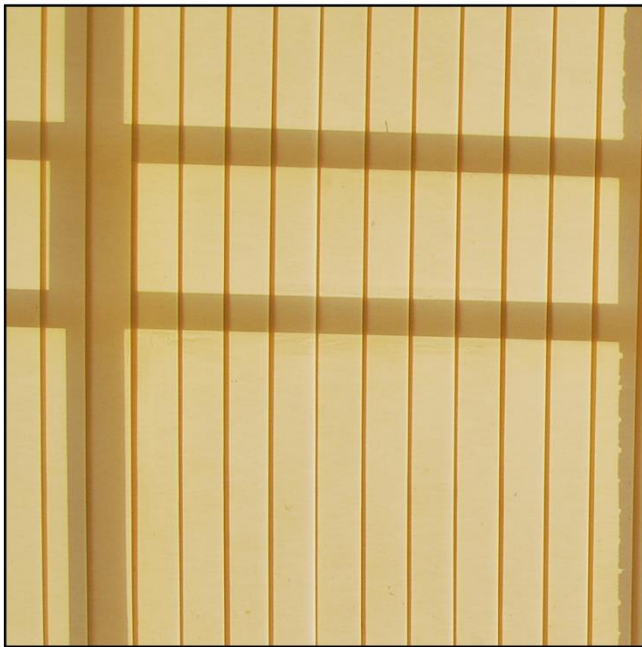

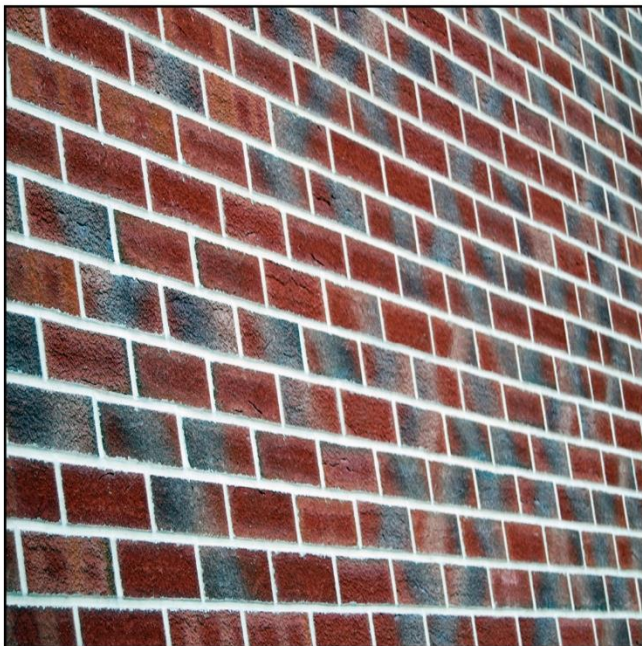
