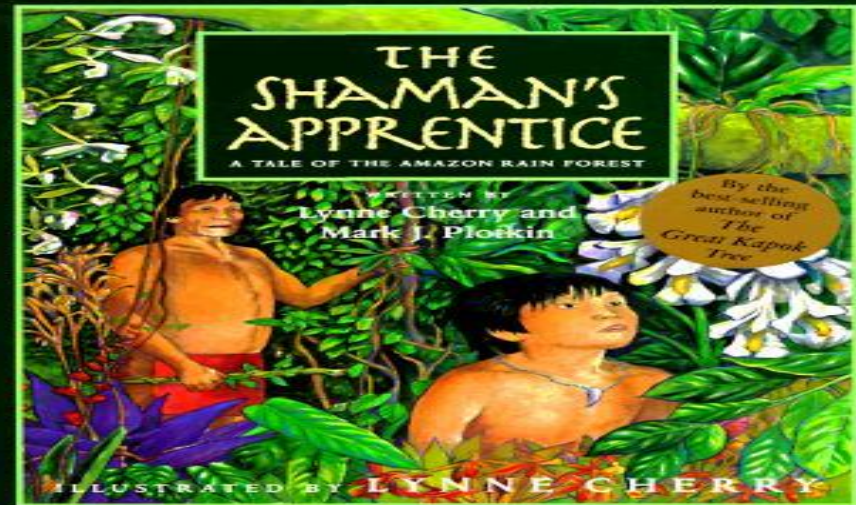

DAY 3 New Text - Retrieval



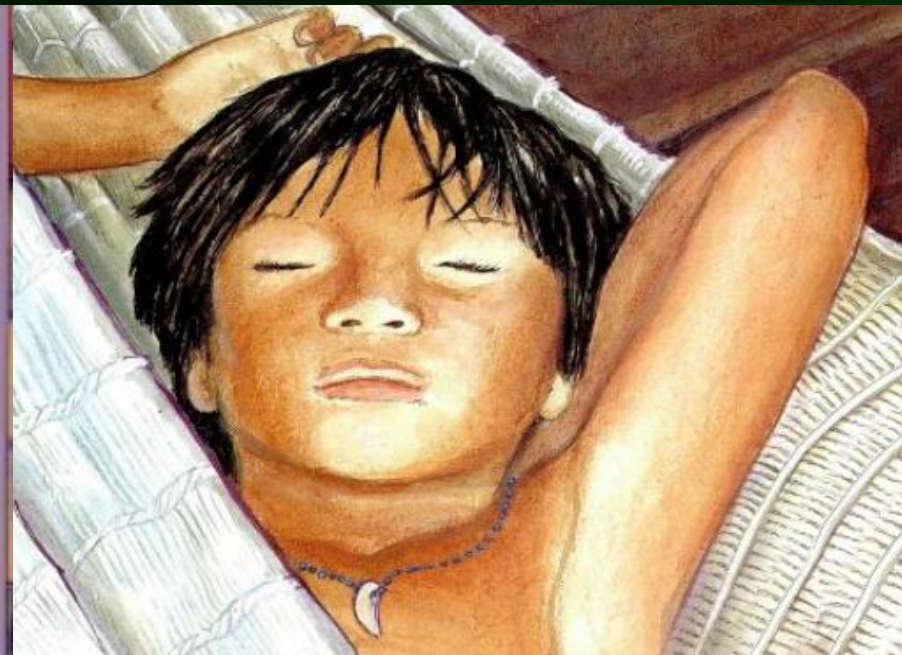
