1. What was he given permission to do?
2. What did he do to help? List 2 things.
3. Where were the soldiers taken to?
4. Was he tired? What word does he use to state how tired he was?
5. Were the explosives noisy? How did they affect his ears?
6. Who was calling for water?
8. Why was he told "That's right, gently now..."

Retrieval Answers:

1. He was given permission to help the wounded.
2. Two out of these three answers - Fetching water, comforting the dying, carrying soldier to the hospital.
3. The soldiers were taken to the hospital.
4. He was tired as the word used was exhausted.
5. The explosives were noisy, it made their 'ear drums throb'.
6. Soldiers were calling for water.
7. He was told to be gentle as the soldiers were wounded.
