If you would like a reminder why our hero mouse is called Resilience, look at the Resilience Assembly slides on the assembly page on our website.




Resilience Mouse would like to introduce you to a new friend:

Can you think of a reason why this brave little mouse might be called after such an important value, specially in this difficult time?






