Writing – English	I can use an adjective to describe a noun.	<p><i>Adult information: All work depends on your child's ability. Let your child do as much independently as they are able. Scribe (use your child's words to write) if necessary but best if your child writes as much as possible even if that is just a couple of words/phrase/one sentence).</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Talk about yesterday's work. (Today children are going to be using an adjective to describe the nouns from yesterday and then writing sentences.)2. Watch https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=QxoDGIPUmyU3. In books make another list: take a noun from yesterday's list and add an adjective e.g. white swan4. When list is complete take each phrase and make into a sentence e.g. 'I saw a white swan'.5. Use 'and' to join two sentences if able.6. Read your work to an adult. Correct as you go through. (If possible let child use a pen to correct. Any mistakes underline and child write correct word below or if it's a capital letter write next to or above. If child writes letters back to front show child the correct way and ask child to do a line of practice).
