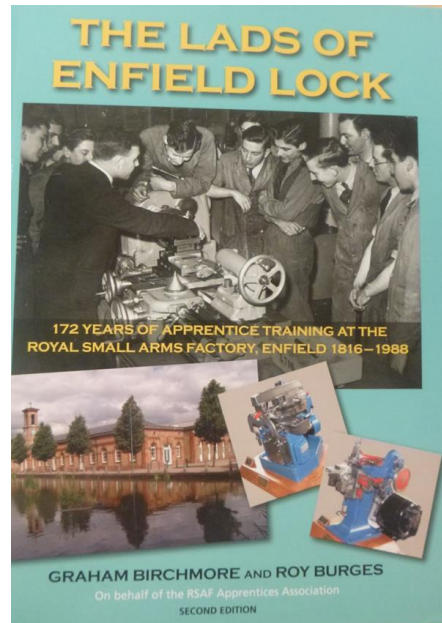


Lesson 6

Our event is the day that a bomb fell on the RSAF

One good thing to come out of this was that when the Germans eventually managed to hit the factory with the parachute bomb in early 1941 (see picture below) there were hardly any people in the factory. The General Stores was completely demolished as was a new building housing the Gauge Room, and also the Drawing Office which had been built on a platform spanning the 'middle river'. This incident took place shortly after night work had been suspended; had it not been so there must have been many casualties.
