- What could happen if they don't arrive soon?

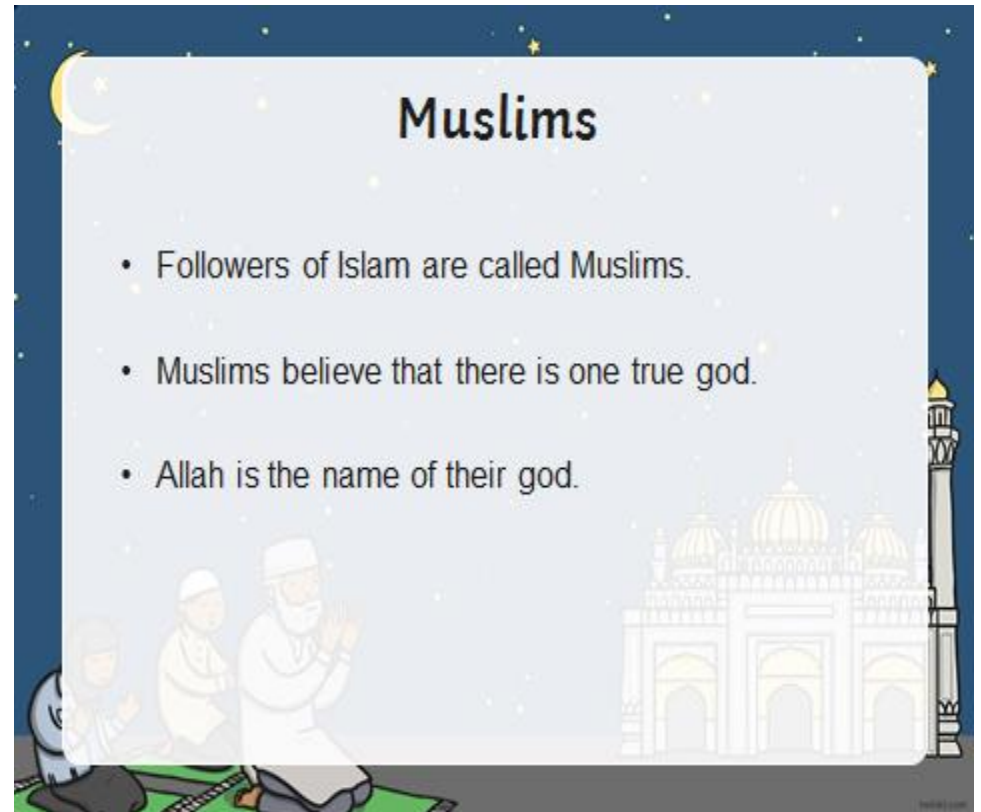
What Do We Know about Ramadan?

- The Qur'an is the important holy book for Muslims.
