Why should we edit our work?

Did you know that when authors write a book or an article, they always have to go through an editing process to make their writing even better.

First they look at the spelling, grammar and punctuation in their writing and then they look at the structure of their sentences and see if they make sense.

This is what we are going to do today.

Grammar and Punctuation

Punctuation Power!	
A	Capital letters for the start of sentences, names and places.
.	A full stop at the end of a sentence.
!	Exclamation marks for exclamations or surprise.
?	Question marks for questions.
'	Apostrophes for showing something belongs to someone.
'	Commas to separate items on a list.
“ ”	Inverted commas around speech.
...	Ellipsis for suspense or long pauses.
