A line that runs from left to right across the page is called a \_\_\_\_\_ line.

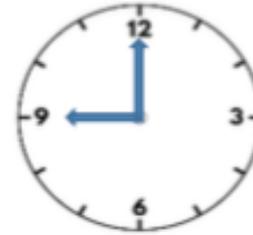
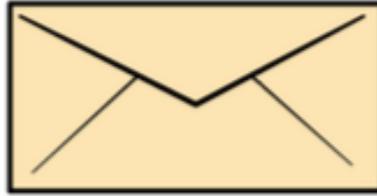
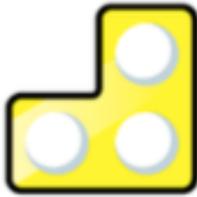
Vertical



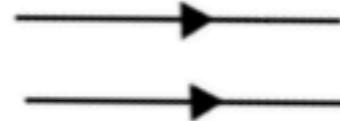
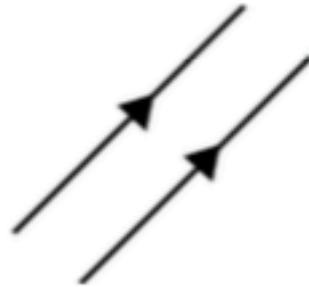
A line that runs straight up and down the page is called a \_\_\_\_\_ line.

Look around your home and out of the window – what vertical and horizontal lines can you see?

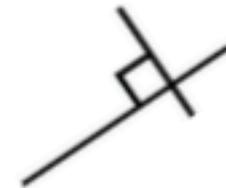
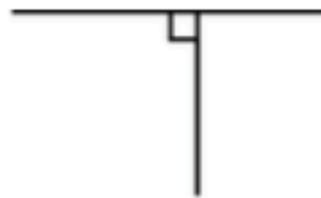
2. Label the horizontal and vertical lines in each of these images.



You can draw these shapes in your book.



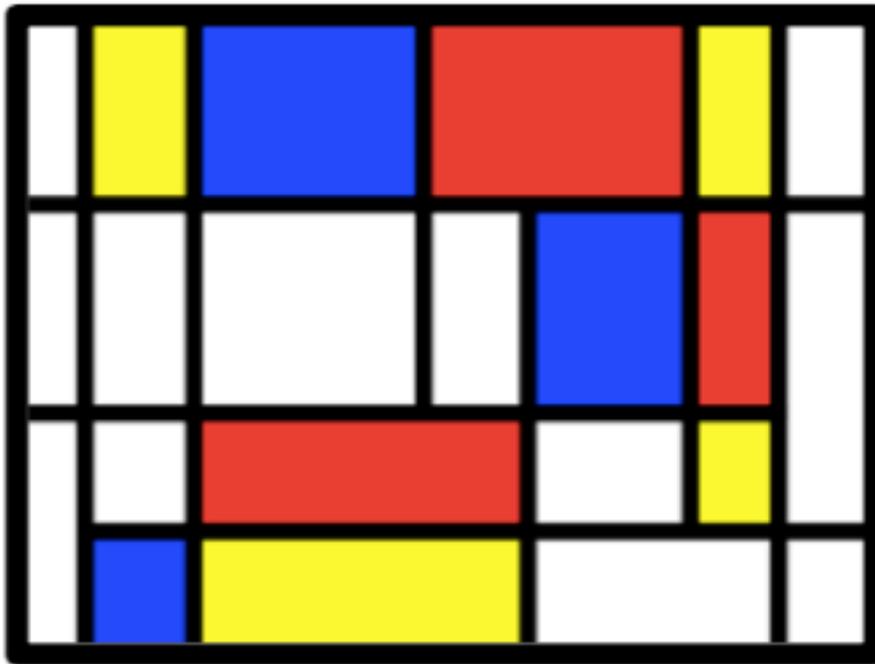
3. Lines that never meet are called parallel lines.



Straight lines that meet at a right angle are called perpendicular lines.
