Warm up – counting practise Watch one of the counting videos below and practise counting actions, sounds or objects. https://central.espresso.co.uk/espresso/modules/ey_0to10/find.html#tab3 Addition – open the power point pdf called ‘Addition’ – slides 4, 5 and 6 only. <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Go through the power point and count the mini-beasts on the screen for slides 4, 5 and 62. Repeat, but now find that number of objects e.g. slide 1, get 2 objects + 3 objects.3. How many altogether?4. Repeat for slides 5 and 6. End – Watch the video ‘Numberblocks Addition’ – can you add along?
