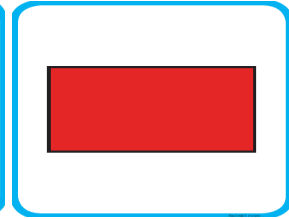
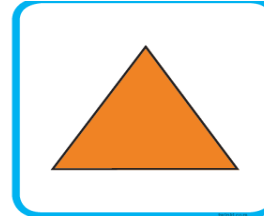
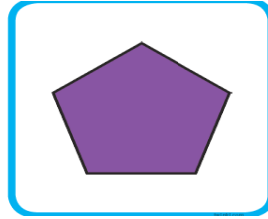
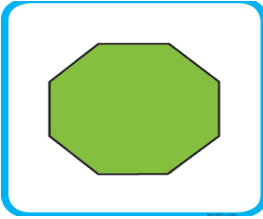
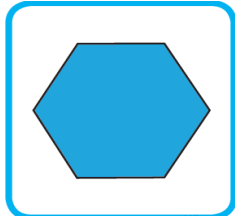
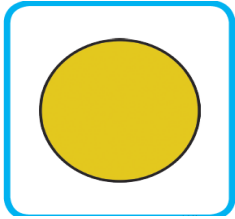
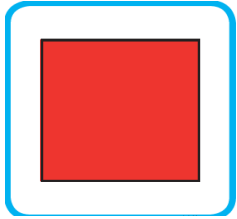
Abigail suddenly looked alert. She had seen something move slightly under the water. She lowered her net and dragged it cautiously across the bottom of the rock pool.
