Organise your leaflet into 'then and now' e.g.

My town(Then)

En mil neuf cent quarante huit, il n'y avait pas de restaurant. *(In 1948, there wasn't any restaurants).*

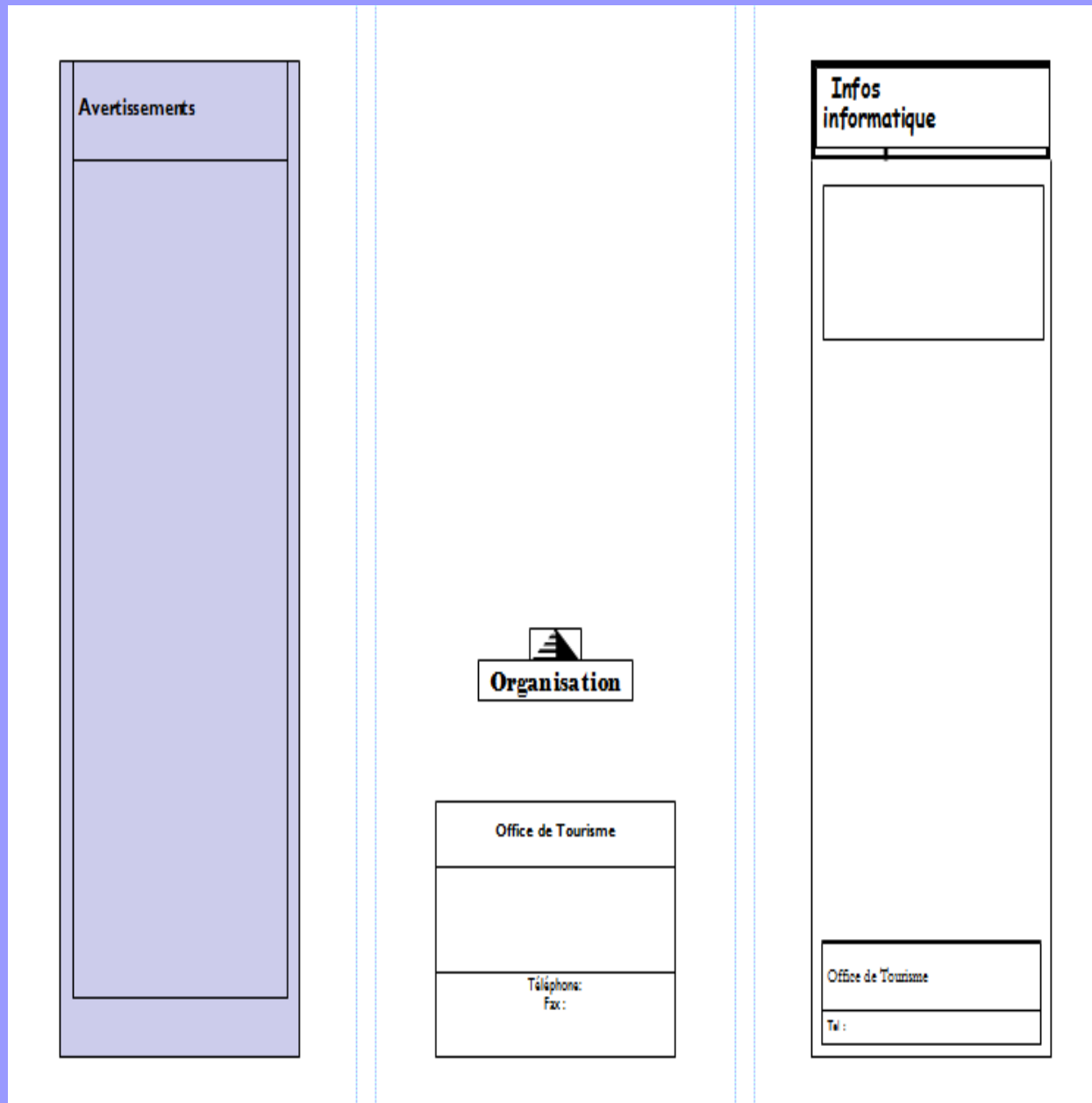
My town(Now)

En deux mille vingt, il y a beaucoup de magasins. *(In 2020, there are many shops).*

Use this template as an example – to be folded into 3 sections

Think about:

- Front cover – Information on name of your town etc.
- The back section – could be name of organisation, address and telephone number
- Advertisements – You could advertise e.g. a museum, a zoo, a tower...
- Inside of your leaflet use lots of pictures and talk about what is in your town – then and now. Use information in the email to help you.



Or use this format.

Remember to include as many adjectives, and phrases as possible.

Here are some **sentence starters**:

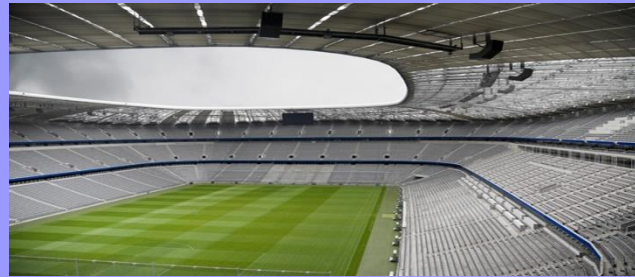
il y a – **there are**

c'est – **It is**

il y avait – **there were/was**

c'était – **It was**
