Now answer the questions.5. Have a go at the challenge.
English	I can orally tell a story	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Write the date and I can in your book2. Try and use the visual clues in the four pictures to put them in the order you think they come in the book3. 'Read' the book to yourself with an adult if possible4. Talk to an adult about what was unusual in the book5. Look at the answer to number 46. See how a teacher used parts of the picture from the book to write down ideas around the window
