Subject	Lesson focus/objective (I can....)	Activity and/or instructions
DGR	I can explore word meaning	This week you will be reading 2 poems from Roger McGough's book of Sensational poems; -Reflect on what you know about Poetry - Read the poem
Mathematics (including times tables)	I can convert from mixed number to improper fraction	You will be looking at different examples of mixed numbers (a number with a fraction) and improper fractions - Read through all the examples to understand what these fractions are and how to convert from one to the other. - The tasks require you to draw examples of fractions
English	I can make predictions about a new book	This week you will be starting a new text. -Read the first paragraph - Answer the questions giving your reasoning
French – Our focus this week	I can recognise patterns in simple sentences	- Read through the poem on Spring PPT- match each line with the English translation - There is also an English version – with names of other animals - Follow the tasks - Remember – the poem has verses and a chorus
Value of the week – COURAGE	At the end of this week we will be celebrating VE Day on Friday 8 th May. Compare how people during the war and people in Covid19 times displayed courage. Later this week you will be given some activities to do at home.
