Use body percussion and or one of the instruments you made yesterday to compose something that represents a river at the source that is the start of the river.

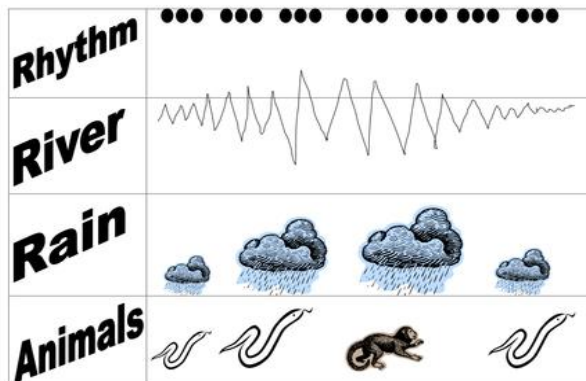
For example:
