I can compose a poem that rhymes

So far you have read a lot of poems that have animals in them. Some of the animals have included:

A rabbit

A rat

An elephant

Snakes

Birds

1. You are going to pick one of these animals and draw it in your book.

2. You are then going to find words that rhyme with the animal and write them in your book.

For example: rat = bat, chat, cat, fat, pat, splat

Bird = heard, word, curd, purred

3. Now you are going to put the words that rhyme into sentences (like the lesson on Wednesday).

4. Write the sentences in your book and then read the poem you have just composed. Don't forget to draw a picture! This is the start of my poem:

A scared bat

When he flew into the wall he went splat

This made him a very upset bat

Because he had lost his favourite blue hat

And then he saw the sneaky rat

Who was incredibly, enormously fat

And a ginger cat

Who was wearing a feathery hat

And looked up menacingly at the bat!
