DGR	I can find synonyms and antonyms.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Open the activity and read through the questions.- Answer the questions and challenge yourself to use different language features.
Mathematics (including times tables)	I can add and convert between proper and improper fraction	Today we will continue to look at proper and improper fractions. <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read through all the examples to understand what these fractions are and how to convert from one to the other.- Challenge yourself with the questions
English	I can visualise a setting	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read the first paragraph- Picture in your head where this could be set. How does it make you feel?- Draw a picture of the setting
French – Our focus this week	I can describe the seasons	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Read the presentation on seasons- Listen to Vivaldi's the four seasons. Does the music sound like the seasons?- Follow the tasks
Value of the week – COURAGE	At the end of this week we will be celebrating VE Day on Friday 8 th May. Compare how people during the war and people in Covid19 times displayed courage. Later this week you will be given some activities to do at home.
