Who has sent her the message? Probably someone she knows.

What is the message about? It could be anything that would upset her. May be that she isn't liked, comments on her looks, clothes she wears or being a snitch.

Why is the girl in the green top looking at her? She is smiling so is getting pleasure from her being upset. She may have sent it or knows the person who has sent it.
