- 1) How did Tash feel when she wasn't invited to the party? She felt left out because she hadn't been invited. She was controlling Abbie and wanted to stop her enjoying herself.
- 2) "Tash was upset and told me not to go." This tells us that:

- 5) How did Abbie feel when the post got more likes? She felt worse and that everyone was watching her.
- 6) Are the girls now friends? They get on better but are not as close as they once were.
- 7) Did Abbie do the right thing to tell an adult? What could she have done differently? She did the right thing in the end but should have spoken to Tash or to an adult more quickly.
