Mathematics	I can use everyday language to talk about time and solve problems.	Listen to this song – What time is it? <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1eGkW3JnthI">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=1eGkW3JnthI</a> Ask your friends and family to play ‘What’s the Time Mr Wolf?’ One person stands with their back to the group and everyone else asks, “What’s the time Mr Wolf?” Mr Wolf says a time, e.g. “4 o’clock” and everyone steps forward 4 steps. Continue with different times, until Mr Wolf says “dinnertime!” and chases everyone back to the start. The person Mr Wolf catches, becomes Mr Wolf next.
Writing	I can use phonic knowledge to write words in ways which match their spoken sounds.	Open the PDF Max’s Jungle talk for writing booklet - <b>Page 21 and 22</b> Choose your favourite jungle animal and write a fact file about it. E.g: My animal is a tiger. It has orange fur with black stripes. It lives in the jungle. It eats meat. Did you know that no two tigers have the same stripes?
