Read through the text p. 21 of the Vanishing Rainforest <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Using the 5minute trick you learnt yesterday, write a short paragraph to describe the setting of the burnt rainforest.- Refer to the 5 senses and the 5 Ws.

Science	I can describe the movement of the Moon.	<p>Today we will be creating a diagram of the different phases of the Moon.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - First, check that you understand the technical vocabulary - match the word to the picture. If you need to, check its' meaning using an online dictionary. - Then, watch the video using the link provided. - Finally, draw a diagram similar to the one on the second slide and label it. Job done!
