I can subtract multiples of 100 from 3 digit numbers.



There were 658 children at a concert.
500 left the hall at the end of the concert.
How many children remained in the hall?

Can you apply the method you learnt yesterday to solve this problem?

Count back in hundreds from 658.

$$658 - 500 = 158$$



658, 558, 458, 358, 258, 158

Look carefully. Only the hundreds change as she counts back.

Practise counting back in hundreds.

Count back in hundreds starting from 705 and stopping at 105.

How many hundreds did you count back?

Count back in hundreds starting from 976 and stopping at 176.

How many hundreds did you count back?

Have a go at the challenge.

Remember for the challenges addition is the inverse of subtraction and vice versa.
