



Reading/Phonics	I can spell high frequency words	Please see weekly phonics – Revisiting set 1,2,3 sounds. Mathematics	I can solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.	<u>I can solve practical problems by sharing out the penguins between the ice blocks.</u>  Explain to your child that some penguins wanted to sit on some ice blocks. Show them the 'share penguin' PowerPoint and talk about how to share the penguins between the ice blocks - write in your book how many penguins are on each ice block. Repeat for all of the slides. Look for the oranges in the painting. If you have an orange at home, draw a picture of the orange. Look carefully at the detail on the orange. Ask a grown up to cut the orange in half or peel the orange. Does it look different? What colours are inside? Describe it to your grown up, Draw a picture of your cut/peeled orange. Optional: If you have paint – can you create prints from your orange? Paint a section of the orange and make a print from it. How can you create different types of prints?
