Mathematics (including times tables)	<u>I can count forwards in 2s ,5s, 10s</u>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Practise counting in 2's by playing the fishing game. <a href="https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/306/Maths-Fishing-Multiplication">https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/306/Maths-Fishing-Multiplication</a></li><li>2. Tap head and shoulders in turn to a rhythm. Count in 2s while you are doing this. Only say the number on the head tap. Number on shoulder tap is said silently. For example, when you tap your shoulder that is 1 (silent). When you touch your head, that is 2. Say it out loud.</li><li>3. Practise with counting in 5s and 10s</li></ol>
Writing – English	I can sequence pictures and retell the story of 'Walter's windy washing line'	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Think about the story so far. You can listen again to the story from yesterday's PowerPoints if you want to.</li><li>2. Open the sequencing PowerPoint.</li><li>3. Drag the pictures so they are in the correct order of how the events in the story unfold.</li></ol>
Weekly task/project	I can describe in simple terms the changes that I notice across the year.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Look through the PowerPoint- Have a look at the picture of the trees in early summer and late autumn. <i>Think about how they look different. What does the tree look like in the summer? What does it look like in the Autumn? What changes can you see? What happens to the leaves?</i></li><li>2. Go for a walk and find a deciduous and an evergreen tree and take a photograph of each tree. Collect a twig from each tree.</li><li>3. Complete the worksheet below.</li></ol>
