Reading/Phonics	I can answer questions about a text	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Read the information about the four different types of online communications.</li><li>2. Answer the questions about the online communications. Send your answers to your teacher and the answers will be uploaded tomorrow.</li></ol>
Mathematics (including times tables)	I can mentally subtract 2 2-digit numbers.	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Look at the problem and have a go at subtracting the 2 numbers.</li><li>2. Look at the strategy of counting back in tens Joan used and discuss with an adult.</li><li>3. Now work 37-30 using the same method. Discuss with your adult once finished.</li><li>4. Have a go at the worksheets using the counting back method.</li><li>5. Then try the 3 challenges.</li></ol>
English	I can write a biographical interview	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Write the date and I can in your book</li><li>2. Read the first page and then talk with an adult about what you think a biography is. Then go to the next page to see the answer.</li><li>3. Watch the video and then write down the 5W's in your book: <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z2yycdm/articles/z2gk9qt">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/z2yycdm/articles/z2gk9qt</a></li><li>4. Read the example and then follow the instruction underneath it</li><li>5. Now read the next page and see the example before you completed your own questions and answers</li></ol>
Computing	I can take photographs using a digital device	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Today we are looking at digital photography so you will need to borrow a phone or camera from an adult.</li></ol>

We would like you to take some pictures, maybe of some plants or berries you may see on your walks outside using a digital device – smartphone or tablet.</li> <li>3. Take a number of pictures of the same plant but from a number of different angles.</li> <li>4. Send your photographs to your teacher and explain which one is your favourite and why.</li> </ol>
Fun corner		Do some bird spotting when you go for your morning exercise. How many different species can you spot? You could take pictures and find out more about them.
