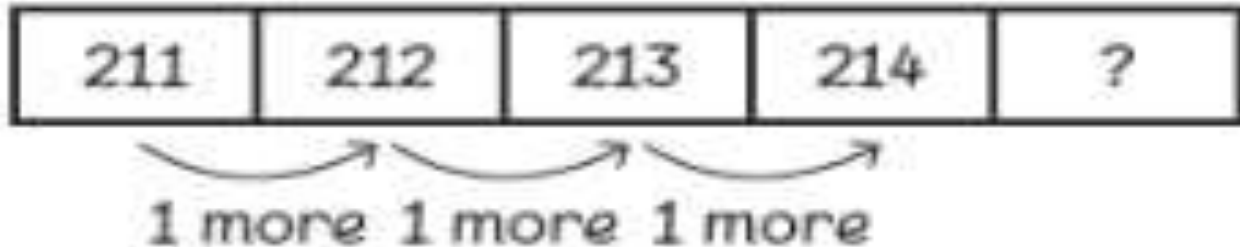


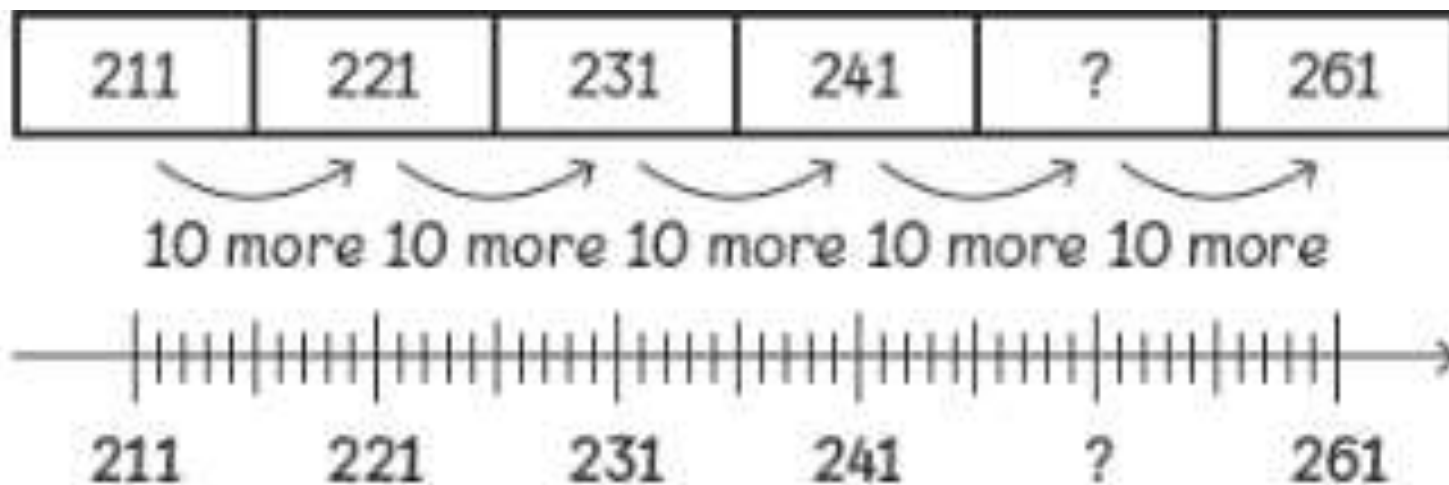

Look at the sequence below. Which digit changes? Hundreds, tens or ones



Look at the sequence below. Which digit changes? Hundreds, tens or ones?



Look at the sequence below. Which digit changes when 400 is added? Hundreds, tens or ones?



213, 313, 413, 513, 613

Count on in hundreds from 213.

$$213 + 400 = 613$$



When 1 is added the 1s digit changes

$$214 + 1 = 215$$

When 10 is added the 10s digit changes

$$214 + 10 = 224$$

When 100 is added the 100s digit changes

$$214 + 100 = 314$$
